Connect Together: Practice Contagious Fellowship (10 min)

Answer the following questions:

As a child, what was Sunday dinner like? What do you like best about Sundays now? Least? Or
How did you/your family spend a normal weekend during your childhood days?

Grow Together: Practice Intentional Faith Development (35 min)

Memory verse: *“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.”*
(Matthew 11:28)

Read the Sunday Texts: Matthew 4:18-22; 11:28-30

Summarize the Sunday message

Host Tip: *Invite people to answer at least **one** of the questions below. If there is time, several can be answered. If your group is larger than 5 or 6 it may helpful to divide into smaller groups of 3 or 4 for discussion.*

1. What insights do you have or what applications are you working on from the Sunday message or the Transformation Journal?
2. Spiritually, are you still preparing the nets? Leaving the boats? Following hard after Jesus? Feeling left behind?
3. Which part of learning to become a disciple of Jesus Christ is most challenging to you? Why? How can your Small Group be of help?
4. “Learning life from Jesus is to respond to God’s act of salvation”. Do you agree? Why? If you disagree, why?
5. After more than a year, our nation’s economy is still not promising. What are some of the physical burdens and yokes people are carrying? If today Jesus was to speak to our nation, what do you think he would say to us? Or what do we need to hear from him most?
6. What are some of the not-so-obvious yoke/burdens you are carrying? How does following Jesus lead to peace and rest?

Serve and Share Together – Practice Risk-taking Mission and Service (10 min)

What can we do to give one last push this week to secure more bed nets for the Nothing but Nets campaign?

Reach Out Together – Practice Radical Hospitality (10)

Name some people you would like to include in your group next week. Lift up the name(s) during Prayer time and as individual.

Worship Together – Practicing Passionate Worship (10 min)

Praise and Worship. Even if this is toward the end of the meeting, lift up the name of Jesus in your midst, praising and giving him the glory.

Prayer is an important part of the meeting. The early (House) church prayed whenever they gathered as followers of Jesus Christ. Jesus said: “where 2 or 3 are gathered together in my name, I am in their midst.” Hold on to this promise so that your prayers will not just hit the ceiling and bounce back but be received by your loving heavenly Father who neither slumber nor sleeps.
